Each candidate will spend Thursday through Sunday with us — leading choir rehearsal, exploring the city, meeting with members of the congregation, interviewing with the Search Committee, becoming familiar with the organ, and leading us in worship on Sunday morning.

Your feedback is an important part of this process! The Search Committee will be asking for input from the choir and the congregation after each visit.

Our first candidate will be with us **March 27–30**, and our second candidate will visit **April 3–6**. We encourage everyone to join us in worship those Sundays to experience these two exceptional musicians and leaders.
